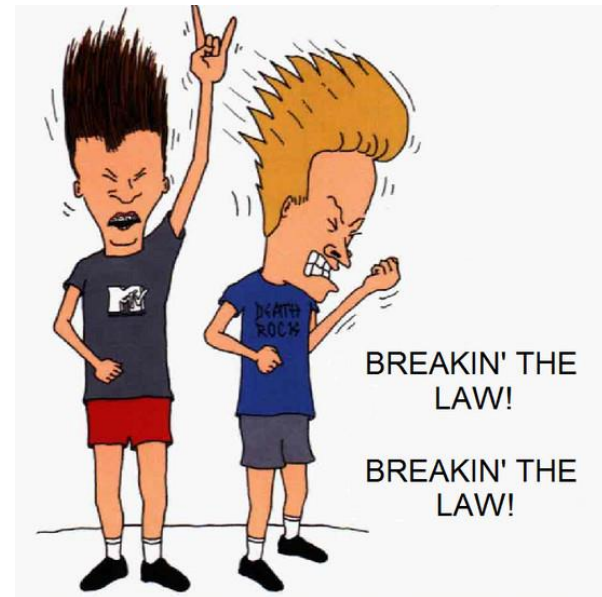


Present simple and present  
continuous



- Present simple: I/you/we/they + base form of the verb, he/she/it + base form of the verb + s
  - Habits, routines, hobbies, things that stay the same
- Present continuous: subject + 'to be' + ING-form
  - Things that are happening right now, things that change



# Examples

- We ... (to sit) right now.
- are sitting
- Every day I ... (to brush) my teeth.
- brush
- We ... (to do) exercises.
- are doing
- Every Friday, I ... (to visit) my grandmother.
- visit



# Examples

- He ... (to wonder) about what happens next.
- is wondering
- She ... (to walk) her dog every day.
- walks
- He ... (to miss) his friends a lot.
- misses

Upon further inspection this is a dog



# Present simple negative



- Present simple negative: I/you/we/they + don't + base form verb, he/she/it + doesn't + base form verb
- !!!! Do not put an s at the end of the verb for he/she/it in the negative form. "He doesn't says" doesn't exist.



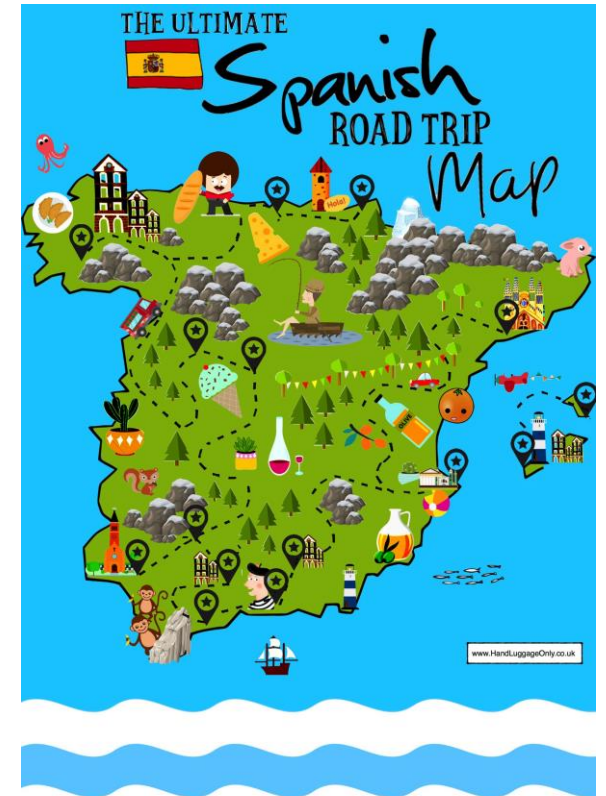
# Examples

- I walk to school.
  - I don't walk to school.
- He likes to go outside.
  - He doesn't like to go outside.
- She has a bicycle.
  - She doesn't have a bicycle
- We like most music.
  - We don't like most music.
- He sounds great singing
  - He doesn't sound great singing



# Examples

- Some people pay attention in class.
  - Some people don't pay attention in class.
- I come from Spain.
  - I don't come from Spain.
- I eat in class.
  - I don't eat in class.
- I see a doctor every week.
  - I don't see a doctor every week.
- I sleep late on school days.
  - I don't sleep late on school days.

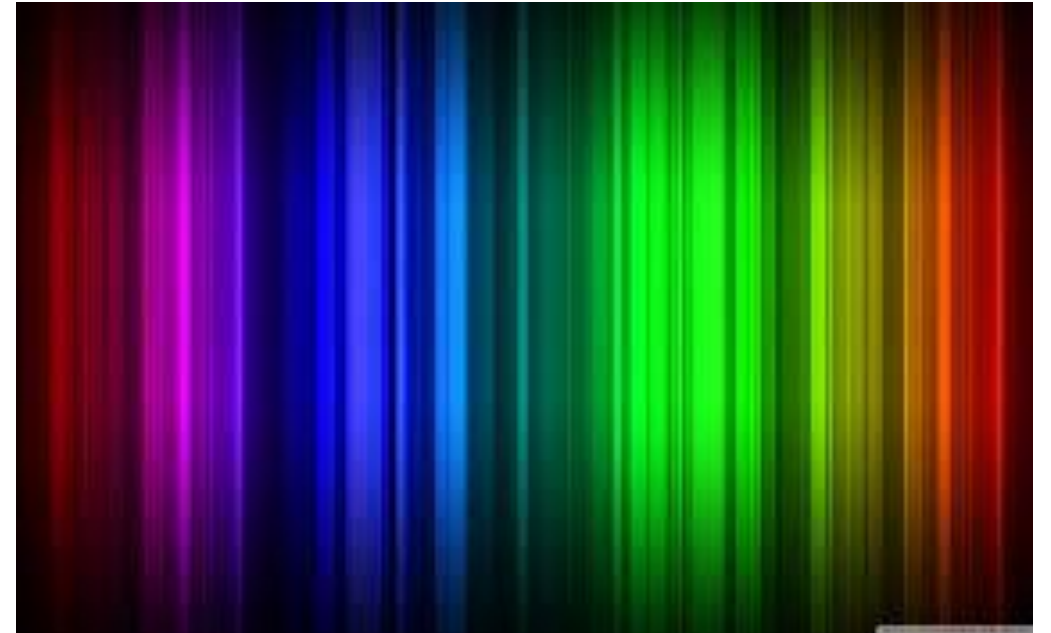
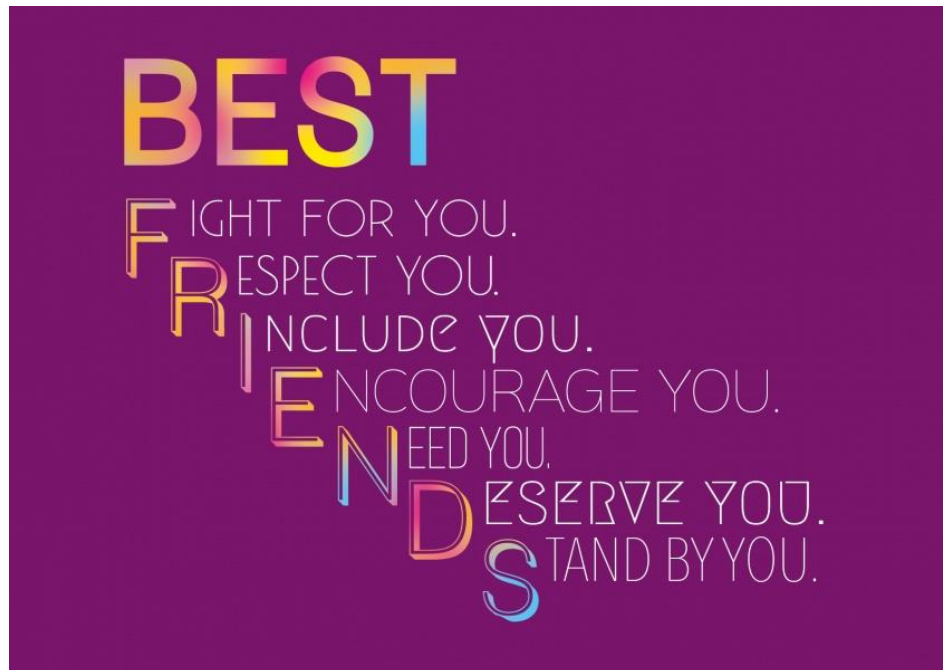
- We ... (to go) outside the school during classes.

- He ... (to like) sports.
- doesn't like
- She ... (to love) her partner anymore.
- doesn't love
- I ... (to see) my friends every day.
- don't see



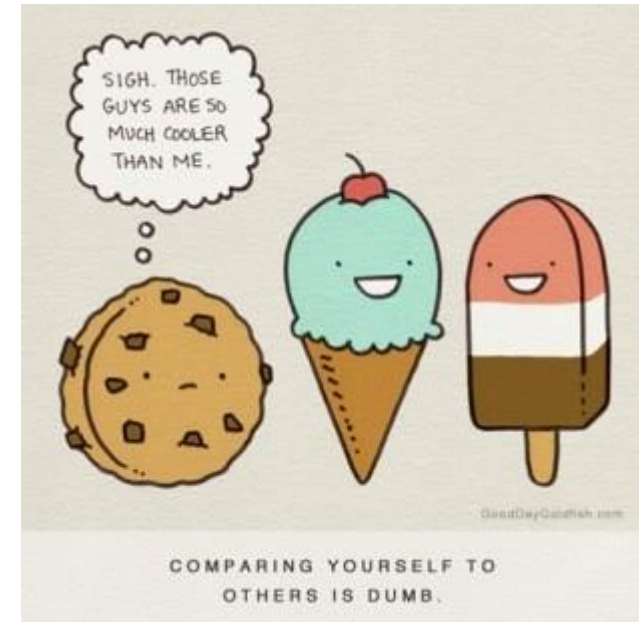
- Do you have a favourite colour?

- How

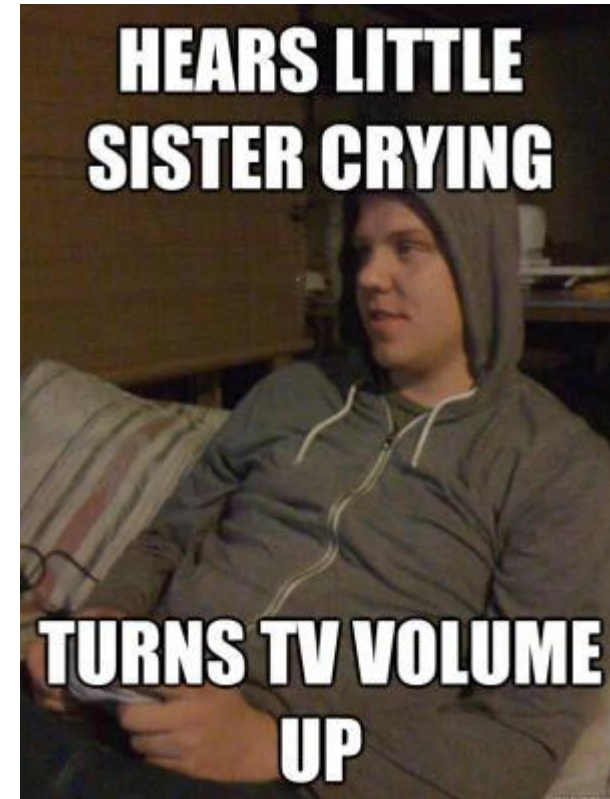

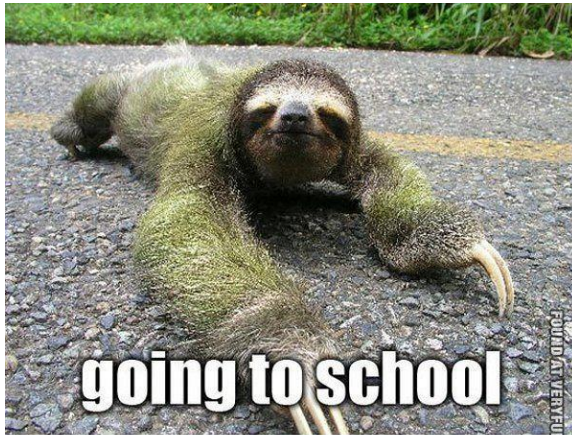


- Do you have any brothers or sisters?
